The versatility of the kiosk means it can perform monthly or variably scheduled probationer check-ins, collect-court ordered fines, fees or restitution, and accept commissary account deposits for incarcerated offenders. Using a simple touchscreen interface, the user can perform these functions remotely at any kiosk location. In addition, the kiosk is equipped with a built-in speaker to assist the user through their transaction(s). On-screen prompts walk the user through the transaction process and are available in multiple languages.

The kiosk uses a secure interface to exchange data with an agency in real-time. The interface is developed in conjunction with the agency to ensure all appropriate safeguards and securities are in place.
